The term "Conflict Minerals" refers to the extraction of four minerals - Tantalum (Ta), Tin (Sn), Tungsten (W) & Gold (Au) in the Democratic Republic of Congo and nearby countries. The production of these minerals is used to finance, directly or indirectly, armed groups in the area, who use violence against the local people as a means of warfare.
